Dear Intermediate II Session Campers and Parents,

Welcome to Arrowbear Music Camp! Please read this letter carefully for important information.

We still have some openings for campers this session. If you especially know of any bassoon, clarinet, trombone, or viola players that would like to come to this session please have them get in touch with us at the phone number or email address at the end of this letter.

ARRIVAL-AUGUST 18th WEDNESDAY

We have scheduled you to arrive with 25 others in order of enrollment. Plan to arrive at or after _____ . We need to empty the camp of cars before the next group arrives. **DO NOT COME EARLY.** We realize there may be conflicts because of the Wednesday arrival and we will try to accommodate you. Please call and leave a message or email the camp: info@arrowbear.com. Check our website for updated maps and driving directions to Camp.

We must accommodate local fire authorities and neighbors by keeping parking in and near Camp. Be sure and leave 10 feet of road width for fire access at all times. Share rides if possible (if carpooling pick one arrival time). If you need names and phone numbers of campers in your area call Camp or email us. We will finish serving lunch (for campers) at 2:00 p.m. and then the camp program will begin. If you must arrive later, please eat before you come.

STARTING THE SESSION AND AUDITIONS

We have planned our first and second day schedule to promote comfortable and appropriate relationships as soon as possible and avoid homesickness. As soon as campers have checked in they will drop off all of their belongings in a designated area, and will be involved in group activities. They will have an opportunity to choose their sleeping area later that day. After we are well into the group process campers will spend a brief time with a staff member demonstrating their musical ability. We need to hear their skill level. They should be prepared to play some scales, part of a prepared piece and sight-reading.

DEPARTURE-AUGUST 28th SATURDAY

The session ends with a performance at 5:00 p.m. Everyone is expected to leave after the concert. Campers will be free to load luggage into cars and visit with families after 3:30 p.m.

WHAT TO BRING--please mark all clothing and personal items with the camper's name.

Bedding (sleeping bag or sheets/pillow)
Toiletry articles and towels
Swimwear and sunscreen
Casual everyday clothes
Clothing for the concert--no set dress code but should be casual/nice
Some warm clothing in case of cold weather (altitude is 6,500 ft.)
Bug repellent and lip balm
Hiking type shoes (tennis or athletic shoes are fine)
Personal stereos are allowed--with headphones and batteries only
Instrument and any music you might want to perform (including piano accompaniment)
Pencils for rehearsals, clothes pins for holding music outside
String players must bring extra strings and reed players extra reeds
Stationery and stamps for letters
Over-the-counter medical supplies (Tylenol, cough lozenges, etc.) will need to be checked in with the health supervisor upon arrival. Camp has basic supplies available in the First Aid Office.

LOST AND FOUND

Arrowbear Music Camp will not be responsible for lost money, clothing, or other valuables. Please leave valuables (except your instrument) at home. On the last day please check your cabin and porch of the first aid building for lost and found items.

Please support the camp experience by **keeping cell phones at home** and planning not to use a phone while at camp. Calls with home and friends seem to cause homesickness and the outside communication interferes with our group building process. If you must bring a cell phone we expect you to keep it in the office building and only use it during breakfast hours or afternoon recreation. Please do not send faxes or emails to campers except in the case of an emergency.

CAMP STORE ACCOUNT

We require campers to turn in spending money for safekeeping. We use a debit system for keeping track of expenditures. Money is needed for the snack bar. We also sell camp T shirts, sweatshirts, water bottles, stuffed animals, and other items. Any unused money will be returned on the last day.

CAMP FEES

The balance of your camp fee is due August 18th. If you did not submit a small photo with your enrollment bring one with you and give it to us at check-in. If you received a scholarship, it is your responsibility to make sure that payment has been sent to camp.

HEALTH FORM

We must have the enclosed health form completed and signed on August 18th. Please do not mail. Campers are not permitted to remain at camp without a completed health form on record. **Make sure that all of the immunization information is current.**

MEDICATIONS, SICKNESS OR INJURY

All medications must be in original containers and checked in with directions for dispensing with the health supervisor upon arrival. In case of sickness or injury during camp, parents will be notified of doctor or hospital visits. **Parents are responsible for all health care and prescription costs.** Generally, Red Cross First-Aid certified staff treats minor scrapes. Paramedics are on call, three miles away. The nearest emergency room is in Lake Arrowhead, 30 minutes away. Campers who take regular medication should bring it to camp with them.

COMMERATIVE PHOTO

A photo will be given to each camper at the end of the session. Campers will also receive a list of staff names, camper's names, phone numbers and addresses. If you do not wish to have your information included please notify us.

SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS

We cannot make arrangements in advance. We have plenty of room for friends to be near each other. Beds will be chosen as you arrive.

LAUNDRY

A washing machine is in each dorm area.

VISITORS

Observers are welcome at any time. Please do not ask to disturb our routine or take campers out of Camp before the session is over.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR FAMILY'S DOG, CAT, OR ANY OTHER PET TO CAMP ON OPENING OR CLOSING DAY.
