Do you love great music? Do you want to come back to school next year a better singer, musician, sight-reader, and artist than you left in June? Would you like to sing one of the greatest choral works of all time (J.S. Bach's *Magnificat*) with 90 fine high school and college age singers from throughout California with a fully professional orchestra? Do you enjoy being outdoors, rehearsing under the pines, playing volleyball, swimming, hiking, rock-climbing, or just hanging out with friends? If so, attend Arrowbear Music Camp this summer.

For ten days, from June 23 to July 2, 2013, four of the finest collegiate and high school teachers from California will be joining forces at Arrowbear for ten *incredible* days of music-making and friendship in the beautiful San Bernardino Mountains. We will be preparing the *Magnificat* by J.S. Bach as well as several shorter choral pieces for a spectacular performance at the end of our session. In addition to traditional choral rehearsals, Arrowbear staff and section leaders will be offering interest sessions in: conducting, vocal jazz, audition techniques and others.

If you auditioned for or participated in one of the ACDA or California Honor Choirs, or if your high school choir participated in the Golden State Choral Competition, Arrowbear Music Camp can offer you a scholarship of \$300. Total cost to you for ten days: \$400. (Regularly \$700). Or, if you partner with another student (at least one of you must be a tenor or bass), you can both come for half price. That is two students for \$700, or \$350 each.
